

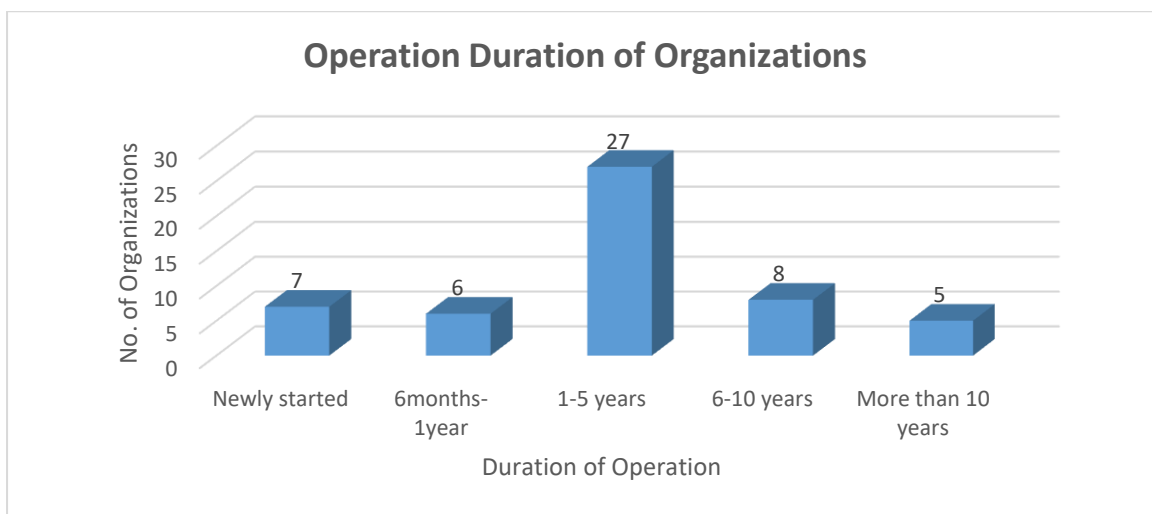
# Report On Slum Database for Volunteer Organizations

Total number of responses received: 60

Total number of responses analysed: 53 (after cleaning data)

## Type of Voluntary Organization:

Most (27 out of 53) of the voluntary organizations are operating for 1-5 years. Eight organizations are operating for 6-10 years and five are operating for more than 10 years. 13 organizations have started their operation within last 1 year.

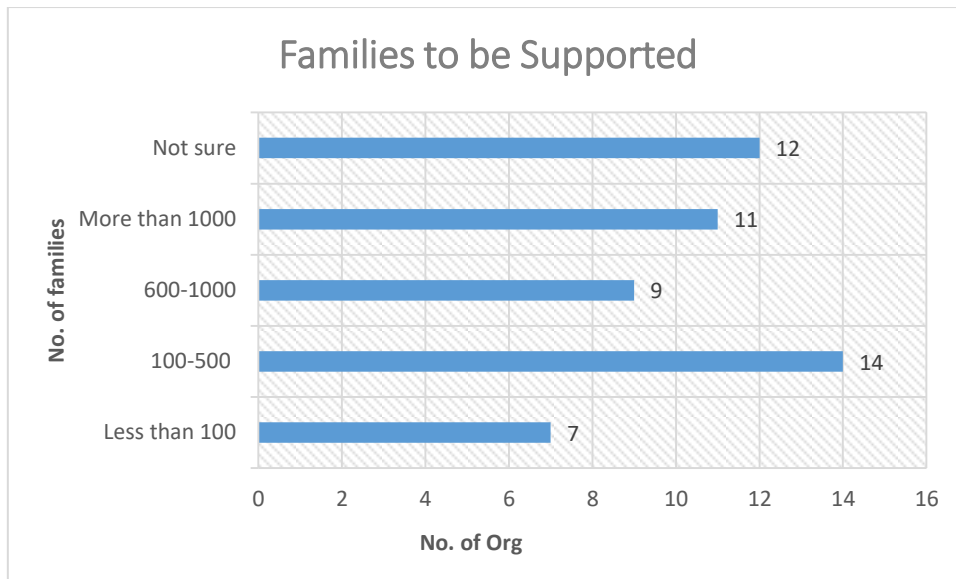


**Chart 1: Duration of Operation of the Voluntary Organizations**

Most of these organizations have a fixed target to support families in different slums in Dhaka, Chittagong, Cumilla, Sylhet and Cox's Bazar. Few have already started their operation. Others are looking for different kind of support.

## Coverage Plan of the Voluntary Organizations

41 out of 53 organizations have specific plan to support families residing in slums during COVID-19 crisis period. Rest 12 could not provide a specific plan. 14 organizations have plan to support 100-500 families. 11 organizations have to support more than 1000 families, 9 are planning to support 600-1000 families and 7 are planning to support less than 100 families.



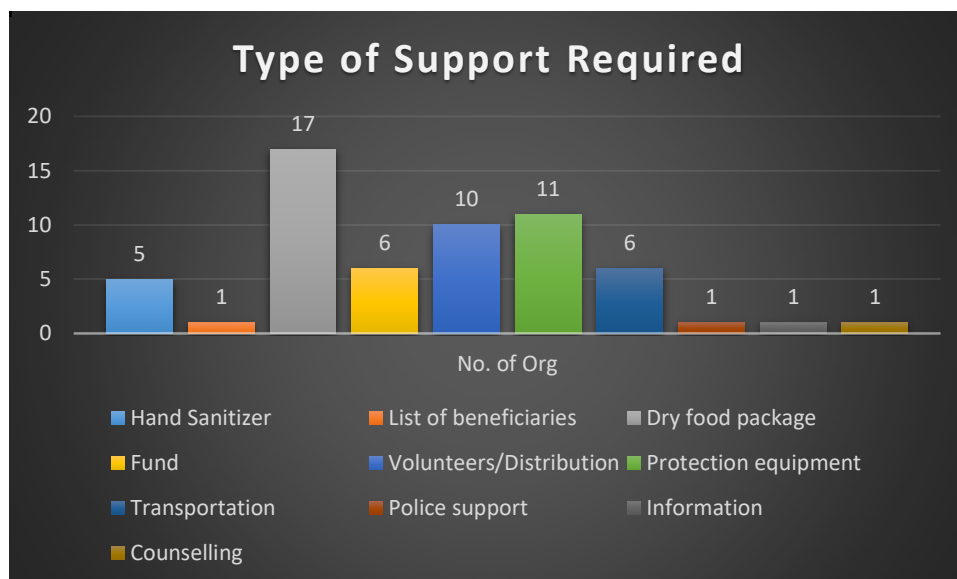
**Chart 2: Number of families to be supported by voluntary organizations**

Out of fourteen organizations who have plan to support 100-500 families, eleven organizations have operational experience of 1-5 years, two of the organizations have 6-10 years of experience and one has newly started. Out of nine organizations who are willing to support 600-1000 families, of them seven organization have 1-5 years of experience and two organizations have newly started. Eleven organizations have the plan to support more than 1000 families, among which six organizations have operational experience of 6-10 years and five organizations have experience of 1-5 years.

### **Support Needed by Voluntary Organizations**

Most of the voluntary organizations have asked for more than one support which has been categorized in 10 broad areas as follows:

- Hand Sanitizer
- List of beneficiaries
- Dry food package
- Fund
- Volunteers/Distribution
- Protection equipment
- Transportation
- Police support
- Information
- Counselling support

Most of the organizations (17) asked for dry food package to distribute. Following that 11 organizations required protection equipment for their volunteers to distribute packages to the slum areas. 10 organizations have asked for volunteer for distribution. 6 have asked for fund, 6 have asked for transport support and 5 have asked for hand sanitizer. 1 organization has asked for support in each of the categories such as police protection, proper information and counselling support. There are few organizations who also mentioned that either they don't need any kind of support or they are not sure what kind support can be availed.

### **Working Area of Voluntary Organizations**

A list of slums is provided in Annex 1 where the voluntary organizations are currently providing support or have plan to provide support. There are duplicative efforts going on in some of the popular slum areas like Korail, Rayer Bazar, Hajaribagh, Mirpur and few slums in Chittagong. These efforts can be made more coordinated through a proper reporting system and real time pinning in the map.

### **Strategies for BRAC to support volunteer organizations**

There are a number of ways BRAC can think of supporting these volunteer organizations mentioned as follows:

- Creating a network of volunteers and providing them a concrete plan of support in slum areas through a coordinated approach.
- Engaging the organizations in distribution where BRAC is not supporting at the moment.
- Partnering with some of the voluntary organizations and provide them with dry food packages for distribution.

- Giving access to the slum map and allowing them to pin their distribution points in the map so that all the ongoing efforts of volunteer organizations can be visible real time in the map to reduce the duplication of efforts.
- Providing some basic support to the volunteer organizations with the available fund of BRAC.
